

Assembly instructions

Before your first game, you must assemble the house. Once this is done, you will be able to put it back into the box without disassembling it.

Components



1 House box



1 Floor board



1 big central wall



Bedroom/Living room

Bathroom/Kitchen

2 small side walls



1 table
1 support beam



1 central joint



1 fire



7 plastic stands

Assembly

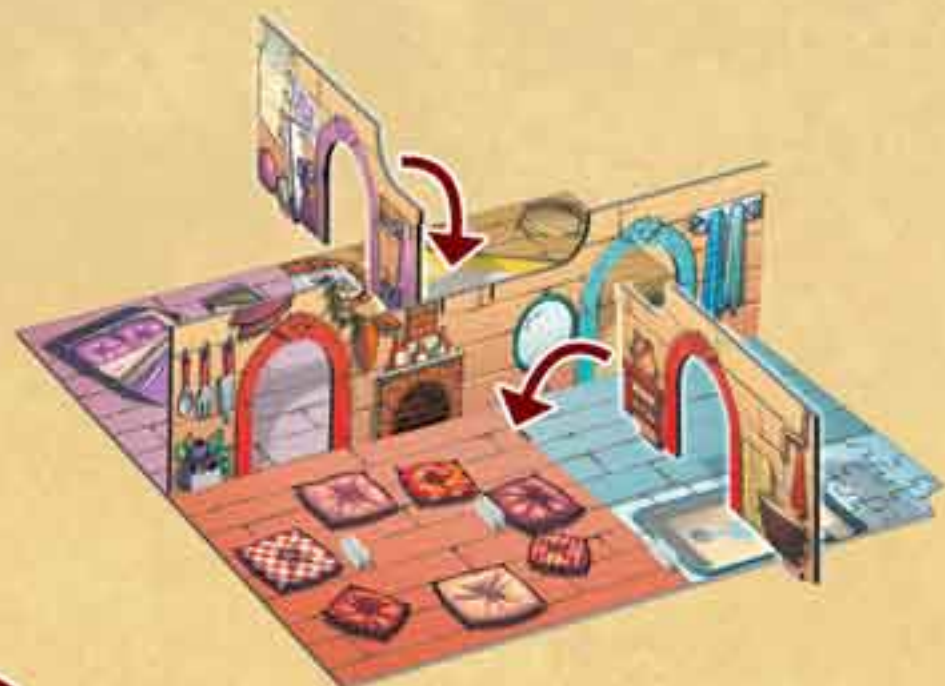
In order to facilitate the task, it is advised to assemble the house on a flat surface.



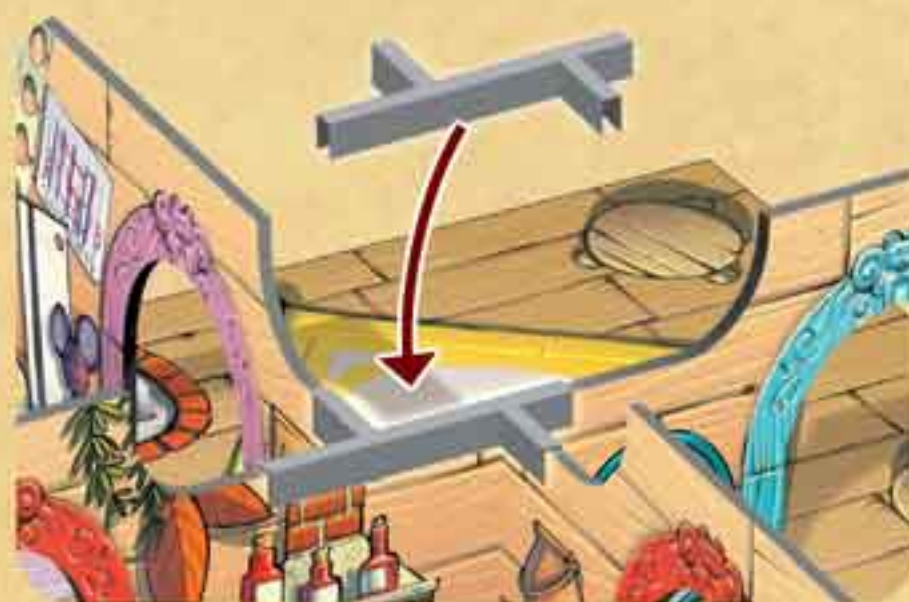
- 1 Insert the 7 stands into the corresponding holes of the Floor board, keeping their flat side under the board.



- 2 Assemble the central wall by inserting its tabs into the stands and holes provided.



- 3 Assemble the first side wall between the living room and the bedroom. Then, assemble the second one between the kitchen and the bathroom.

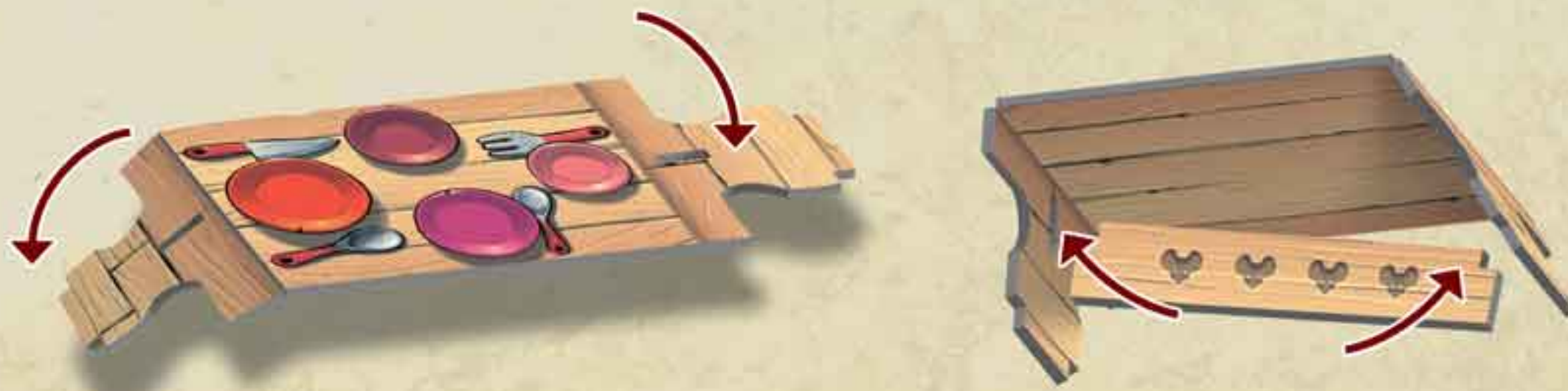


- 4 Place the central joint at the intersection between the side walls and the central wall.



- 5 Mount the fire on the provided stand, in the living room.





- 6** Fold the table following the dotted lines. Then, insert the support beam into the slots provided under the table, making sure the mice heads are not upside-down.



- 7** Mount the table on the provided stands, in the middle of the kitchen.



- 8** Place the black insert inside the lid of the box (marked with flowers) following the pattern on the bottom of the lid.



- 9** Put the Floor board over the plastic insert matching up the notch of the bathroom with the notch of the plastic insert. Next, place the roof on top of it using the ivy and the ladder as reference.



- 10** Assemble both the Mouse and Basket standees with their corresponding cardboard support.

The house is now ready for your first game!

Storage

Put the tokens, wooden disks, meeples and flashlight back into the box. Turn the Floor board upside-down and store it without disassembling it, with the table in the provided slot, matching up the notch of the bathroom with the notch of the plastic insert. Add the Question boards and, lastly, slide the roof of the house over the top.
